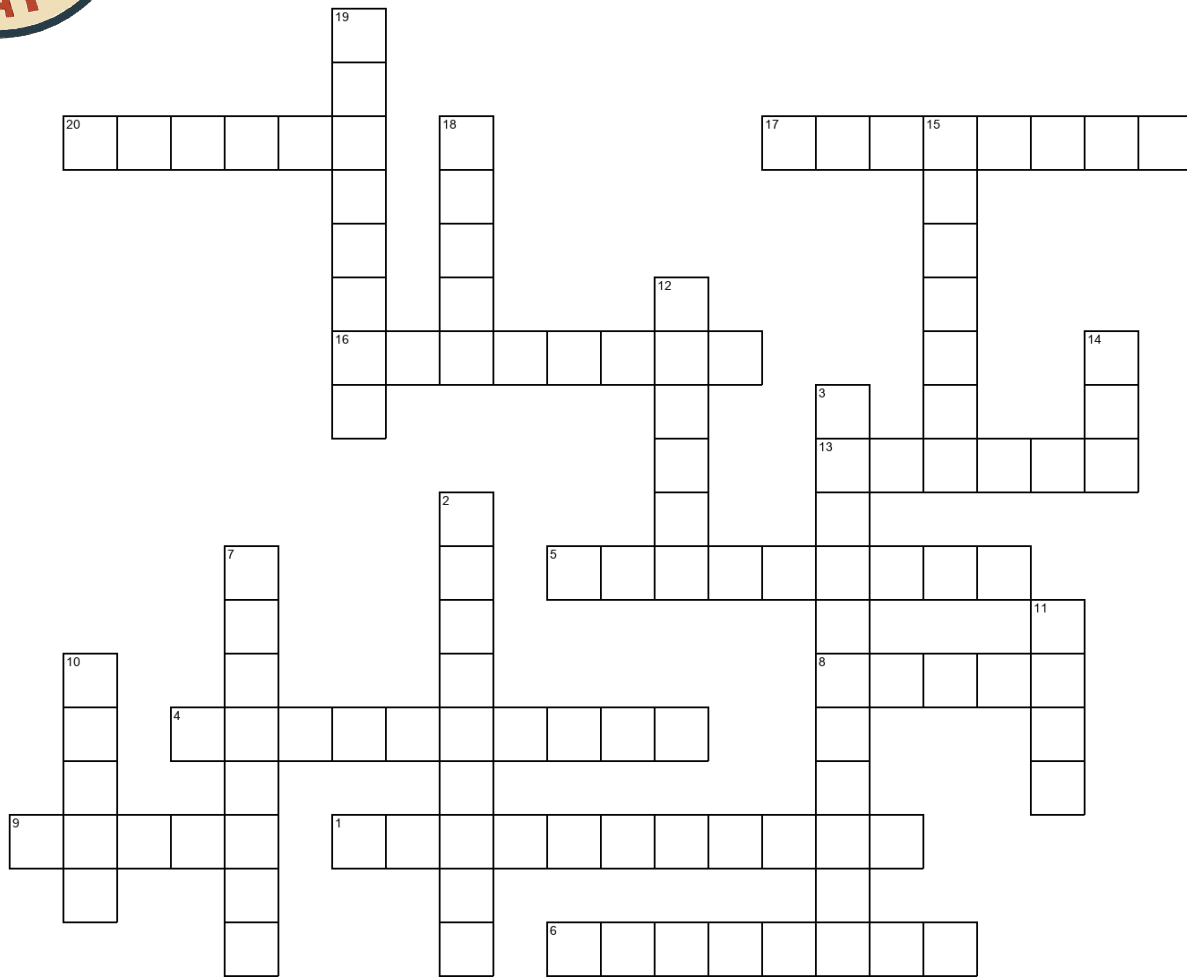

1. Guitar technique using a single pick for melody lines
4. Ensemble made up entirely of string instruments
5. Fast instrumental tune often used to showcase skill
6. Small, eight-string instrument often providing the chop rhythm
8. The speed at which a tune is played
9. Five-string instrument central to bluegrass rhythm and drive
13. The steady beat that drives a song
16. Describes bluegrass instruments played without amplification
17. Vocal style featuring a high lead with lower harmonies
20. Words of a song

2. Genre named after a type of grass and a Kentucky band
3. Style rooted in early acoustic American music
7. Fast mandolin technique that creates the signature chop sound
10. Instrumental solo within a song
11. Repeating banjo picking pattern
12. Bowed string instrument essential to traditional bluegrass melodies
14. Informal group music session
15. Layered vocal style that defines the bluegrass sound
18. Resonator guitar commonly used for sliding bluegrass leads
19. Outdoor event where bluegrass music is commonly performed
